**FROM THE PASTORAL CENTER – PRIEST MEDICAL INSURANCE**

Did you know that it cost the Eparchy \$240,000.00 a year for medical insurance for both the active and retired priests? Medical insurance premiums are out of sight and still on the rise. How does our little Eparchy manage to pay this monthly premium? The parishes pay most of the premium for their priest and the Eparchy picks up the difference. With the last increase in premiums last May, the parishes were asked to assume the full increase in increments by next January. Small and large parishes are being crushed by the increase now. What will happen in January? Will our parish be able to survive another expected increase come May, 2012?

**Weekly Byzantine Tradition Fact:**

**When to Bow & When to Cross**

- When Father Incenses \* Bow Only\*

**Why? At the beginning of Liturgy, the offering of incense is actually a penitential act. The bow there should be performed with a sense of contrition for sin. During the other times of incense the Priest is honoring the Image of God in each one of us and therefore a bow is appropriate.**

- When Father uses his hand, the Cross, or the Sacrament to Bless us \*Bow and Cross\*

**We bow and cross ourselves during these times because we are being blessed by them.**

- When the Trinity is Mentioned \*Bow and Cross\*

**We cross ourselves in reverence to the mention of the Most Holy Trinity and bow to the honor of Christ.**
